9 507625- CAPITAL WORKS AND OTHER ITEMS OF INTEREST

R40-0022

Members considered a report regarding the planned capital works in the Waimarino-Waiouru Community Board area in 2010/2011. Deryck Brown queried whether the Cyprus Trees in Seddon Street and the Cherry Trees in Goldfinch Street have been removed. Members discussed the following points in more detail:

- Item 14 – Ohakune Wastewater Septage Facility – This was installed in the Ohakune Treatment Plant.

Unconfirmed

- Item 13 – Burns Street, Ohakune – File note tabled (document 509033). Two valves have been installed so that one side of town can be turned off (for repairs etc) but supply still available to the other areas.
- Item 18 – Grease Traps, Oil Interceptors and Water Supply Backflow Prevention Survey – Grease traps are going to be compulsory in all food outlets. The Environmental Health Officer is currently in the process of educating food outlet owners.

The Team Leader Environment, Anne-Marie Westcott updated Members on Members Information Requests previously received.

- Water Extraction Submission – The Team Leader Environment needs more information regarding exactly what the Community Board wants to know. Most of the information requested can be found at www.horizons.govt.nz – water matters. All water consent information is available on that website.
- Raetihi Hydro Scheme – More consents have now been requested than were originally applied for. The Hearing is not expected to be held until at least October 2010. Council have submitted an objection.
