#### **NEW LOCATION FOR WAIMARINO BRASS BAND**

The Waimarino Brass Band finally has a plot of land to relocate their building to from its current location in the grounds of the Ohakune Holiday Park.

Ruapehu District Council Group Manager Environmental Services, Margaret Hawthorne, said that council has approved the allocation of an area of Rochfort Park off Ohakune Rd for the relocation of the Waimarino Brass Band building.

"Subject to Resource Consent being granted for the relocation of the building council will lease the land to the Waimarino Brass Band on a long term peppercorn rental," she said.

"The new site in Rochfort Park is not far from the site set aside for the new St Johns Ambulance Station."

Mrs Hawthorne said that the negotiation on the general terms and conditions of the proposed lease will be undertaken by council's Chief Executive.
