

Ruapehu District Council Service application deadlines for Christmas / New Year period

Over the Christmas and New Year period there are some changes to Council services that affect application deadlines and turn-around times for some of Council's certificates and licences.

Ruapehu District Council office closures

Council offices in Taumarunui and Ohakune will be closed on Wednesday 28, Thursday 29 and Friday 30 December. The Raetihi office will be open from 8:30am to 3:00pm on these days.

Application deadline changes

Liquor Licencing

General licence

Anyone needing a new liquor licence or certificate, or needing to apply for a liquor licence renewal, over the Christmas / New Year period should ensure that their application is with Council on or before Monday 19 December.

Special liquor licence

Applications for Special Liquor Licence's for events or functions over the Christmas / New Year period must be received by Council on or before Monday 12 December (ten working days prior to Friday 23 December).

If you need a Special Liquor Licence and miss this deadline please call Tanya O'Shannessey at Council to discuss your situation.

LIM Reports

LIM applications will not be processed on the three days that Council is closed between Christmas and New Year (28, 29, 30 Dec). Processing times for a 'normal' LIM Report is ten working days. 'Urgent' LIM Reports have a processing time of five working days.

Resource Consent & building department requests

Government legislation requires that consent applications are processed within 20 working days of receipt. The days from Monday 19 December 2011 to Wednesday 11 January 2012 will not be counted as 'working days'.

Any Consent applications received during this period will not have these days included as part of the legislated 20 working days for processing.

Transfer Stations & kerbside collection

Transfer Station opening hours

All Ruapehu Transfer Stations are closed on Christmas day and New Year's day. They are open every other day as per their normal opening hours.

Kerbside collection

Kerbside collection will take place as per normal on their normal days:

Ohakune, Rangataua and Raetihi:

Monday 26 December and Monday 2 January

Taumarunui, Piriaka, Mahoe and Kakahi:

Thursday 29 January and Thursday 5 January.
