NOTES FOR SPECIAL LICENCE APPLICATION

1. **Details of Applicant**
 - (a), (b) The name and postal address of the Association applying for the Special Licence, i.e. the group organising the event, e.g. Ohura Yacht Club, PO Box 20, OHURA.
 - (c) Tick the group which best describes the applicant. If 'other' chosen, please elaborate.
2. **Details of Premise**
 - (a) Physical address (or addresses) where the event is being held, e.g. Waimarino Cricket Clubhouse, Seddon Street, Raetihi
 - (b) If the group applying for the Special Licence does not own the premise the event is being held in, signed permission from the owner of the premise is required stating they have no objections to the premises being used and it is acknowledged alcohol will be sold and supplied on the premises.
3. **Designation**

When underage persons will be present at the event, the District Licensing Agency requests that areas where alcohol is sold and consumed are designated as either '**restricted**' or '**supervised**' and separated from other parts of the venue, e.g. the bar area could be roped off.

Restricted - Area where only drinking age persons are allowed.
Supervised - Area where alcohol is allowed and underage persons are supervised.
Undesignated - Area where alcohol is allowed.

Alcohol sale or consumption is not permitted outside the stated areas. Since the Smoke Free law was introduced it has been common for an appropriate outside area to be designated.
4. **Details of Event**

One Special Licence can be applied for to cover the same event on several different occasions at the same venue, e.g. 'After Match Function' each Saturday over the season, or one event, e.g. over a weekend, which takes place at more than one venue, e.g. 'Reunion' with events in different halls.

 - (a) There can be only one event
 - (b) There may be more than one date.
5. **Conditions**
 - (a) Please provide a menu/examples of snack food that will be readily available, and any meals to be provided. Food must be available throughout the event.
 - (b) A free telephone, taxi service available, and courtesy van are examples of assistance with transport.
 - (c) Low alcohol and non-alcoholic drinks such as soft drinks, tea and coffee, should be available as an alternative.
 - (d) Clear instructions to staff regarding proof of drinking age and not serving inebriated persons, displaying posters about underage drinking and drink driving etc, and a commitment to the requirements of the Sale of Liquor Act 1989 are examples of what is required here.
 - (e) Will drinks be sold in glasses, cans, bottles, or all three.
 - (f) A plan showing –
 - (i) Those parts of the premises that are to be used for the sale or supply of liquor; and
 - (ii) Those parts of the premises (if any) that the applicant intends should be designated as restricted areas or as supervised areas.
 - (g) *(Where the applicant is not the owner of the premises)* A written statement from the owner to the effect that the owner has no objection to the grant of the licence.
 - (h) The prescribed fee.
6. **Details of Manager**

One or more Managers need to be named. In most cases they do not have to hold a General Manager's Certificate, but they need to be aware of the conditions of the Special Licence and have some experience with the sale and supply of liquor. The named Manager needs to be on the premises at all times, which is why it is sometimes necessary to have more than one person named.

It is important that the contact person can be contacted during the working day. They are considered the representative of the Applicant.

Please be aware that the LLI may require additional information or changes to hours, personnel, etc which may delay the processing of your application. Securing a Special Licence *before* advertising the event will ensure that your event proceeds as planned.

EVACUATION SCHEMES FOR PUBLIC SAFETY

An Evacuation Scheme is required if:

The building is used as a place where 100 or more people are able to be present for different purposes or activities, or if

**The premises have no sprinkler system (or an inadequate sprinkler system)
and**

If the building contains facilities for employment for more than 10 people; or
Accommodation is provided for more than five people
(Fire Service Act 1975, Section 21A).

Note:

The National Fire Commander may grant waivers from the requirement of any building, where in the opinion of the National Commander, there are already other provisions which will ensure the safety of people within the building (Section 21A(9)).

This certificate is to be completed, signed and returned with your renewal application, **even if your building is exempt.**
