The Board received addresses as follows:

Winston Oliver

- Reported on the loud noise and camp site parties resonating from the Ruatiti Domain after hours; no signs are posted in this area and compliance officers usually arrive too late to experience the noise therefore no action is taken.

- Also gravel roads (country roads), culverts, water tables are poorly maintained by Inframax in some areas. Councillor Nottage confirmed Mr Oliver's complaint stating that the culvert on Mangateitei Road is blocked and overflowing.
- The maintenance of the State Highway is in question where in some areas poorly maintained road side lawn is frequently littered with garbage. Chairperson Compton stated that State Highway is lacking in maintenance.
- Chief Executive Peter Till advised that roads are inspected on monthly basis by Inframax.
