- Raetihi Promotions would like a barrier put up at the Makotuku Walkway to prevent horses and quad bikes from entering this walkway.
- The sign in Raetihi that points to the Whanganui National Park is confusing to travellers who want to go to National Park Village. Enquired if the name on this sign could be changed .

- Enquired if the Cabbage Tree off Goldfinch Street, Ti Kouka Place, Ohakune is to be cut down, as the Board asked for it not to be and there are now two new ones planted there.
