

PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES Ohakune Mardi Gras 2018



Pursuant to the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965 notice is hereby given that the Ruapehu District Council for the purpose of holding the Ohakune Mardi Gras on Saturday 23 June 2018 is proposing to close the following streets.

During the proposed period of closure, the following provision will be made for ordinary vehicular traffic which would otherwise use the street(s):

STREETS PROPOSED TO BE CLOSED TO ORDINARY VEHICULAR TRAFFIC:

Thursday 21st June 1.00pm to Sunday 24th June 1.00 pm

West end of Thames Street closed – access via Tyne and Rimu Streets

Saturday 23rd June and Sunday 24th June

7.00am to 3.00pm Saturday - Thames and Rimu Streets managed closure. Drive through access and ski shop parking available

3.00pm Saturday to 3.00am Sunday - full closure of Thames, Tyne and Rimu Streets. Tyne Street residents will have access to their properties. Parking will be unavailable on Mangawhero Terrace from Tyne Street to bridge, Tyne Street (full length) and west end of Railway Row.
