

Local Alcohol Policy Adoption



Ruapehu District Council gives notice pursuant to section 90 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and Regulation 19, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 that the Provisional Local Alcohol Policy adopted 14 February 2018 has ceased to be provisional.

The Local Alcohol Policy (LAP) received no appeals and came into force on 29 March 2018.

There has been a delay in public notification due to a delay in receiving information from the Alcohol Regulatory and Licencing Authority (ARLA) regarding appeals.

In summary, the LAP states:

- The maximum hours for all Club-Licences remains Monday to Sunday, 9am to 1am the following day
- The maximum trading hours for On-Licences remains:
 - Waimarino-Waiouru and National Park Wards: 8am – 3am
 - Taumarunui and Ohura Wards: 8am – 1am
- Off-Licences hours have been amended to reflect the following conditions:
 - Supermarkets / Grocery Stores: 7am – 10pm
 - All other Licence Holders: 9am – 10pm
