

Ruapehu District Council (RDC) is committed to making a final decision on the future supply of drinking water in Ohura with the current scheme being unsustainable in its current form.

RDC has prepared a detailed report that includes the assessment and comparison of four alternative options and their costs. **Ohura ratepayers, residents and other interested parties** are urged to thoroughly familiarise themselves with the latest information in the report, **complete a 'preferred option survey' and attend the community meeting at the Ohura Hall on Thursday 12 September starting at 3.30pm**.
