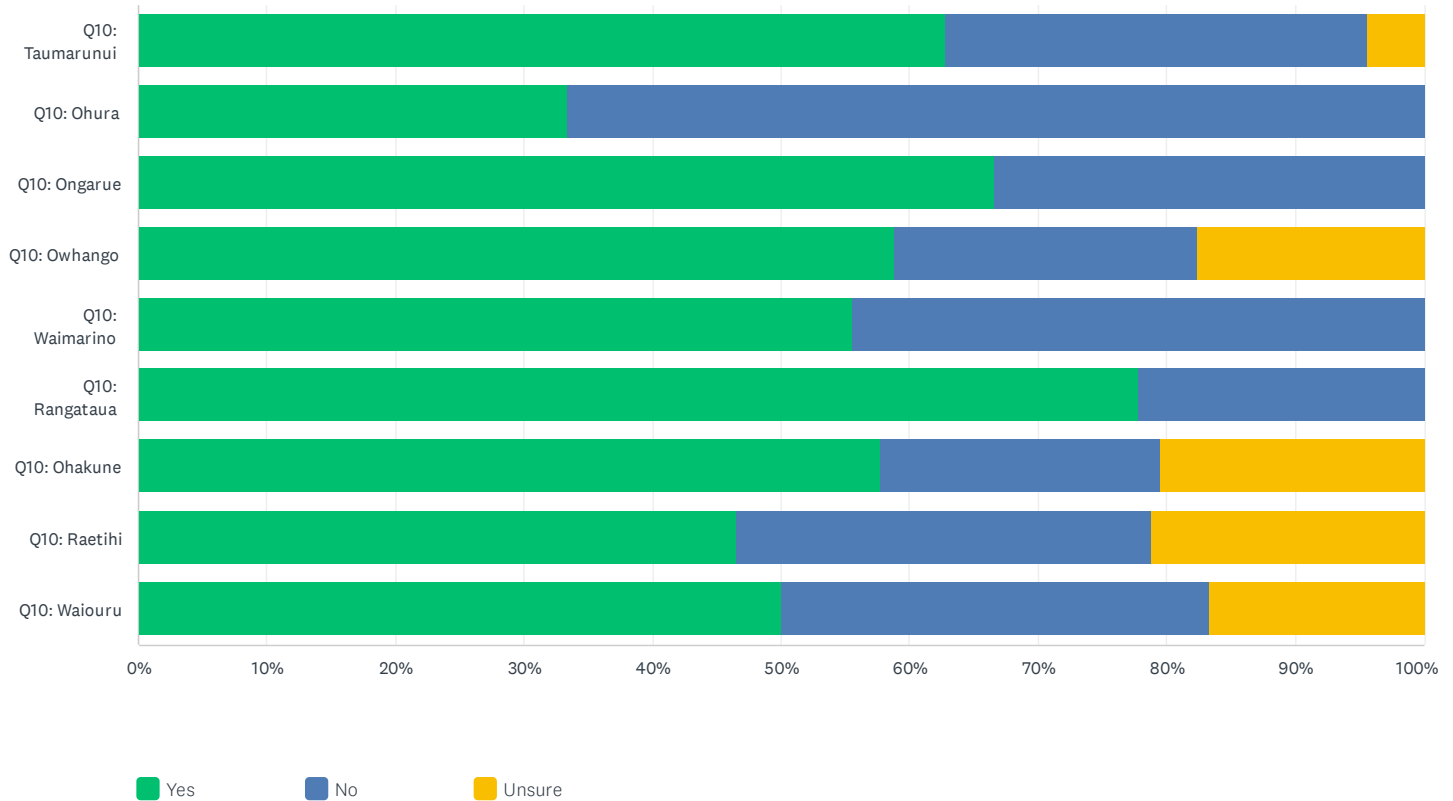


Q1 Should Council prioritise investment on Class 1 roads over lower-use roads?

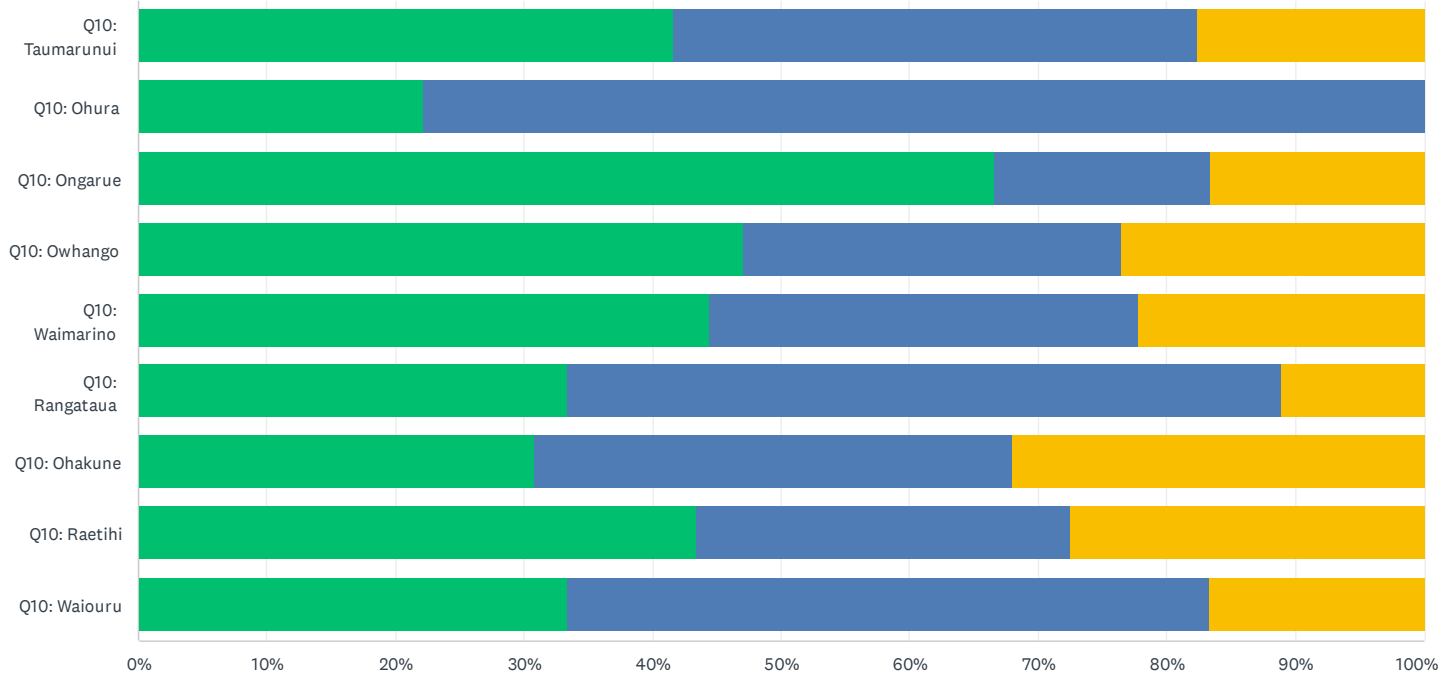

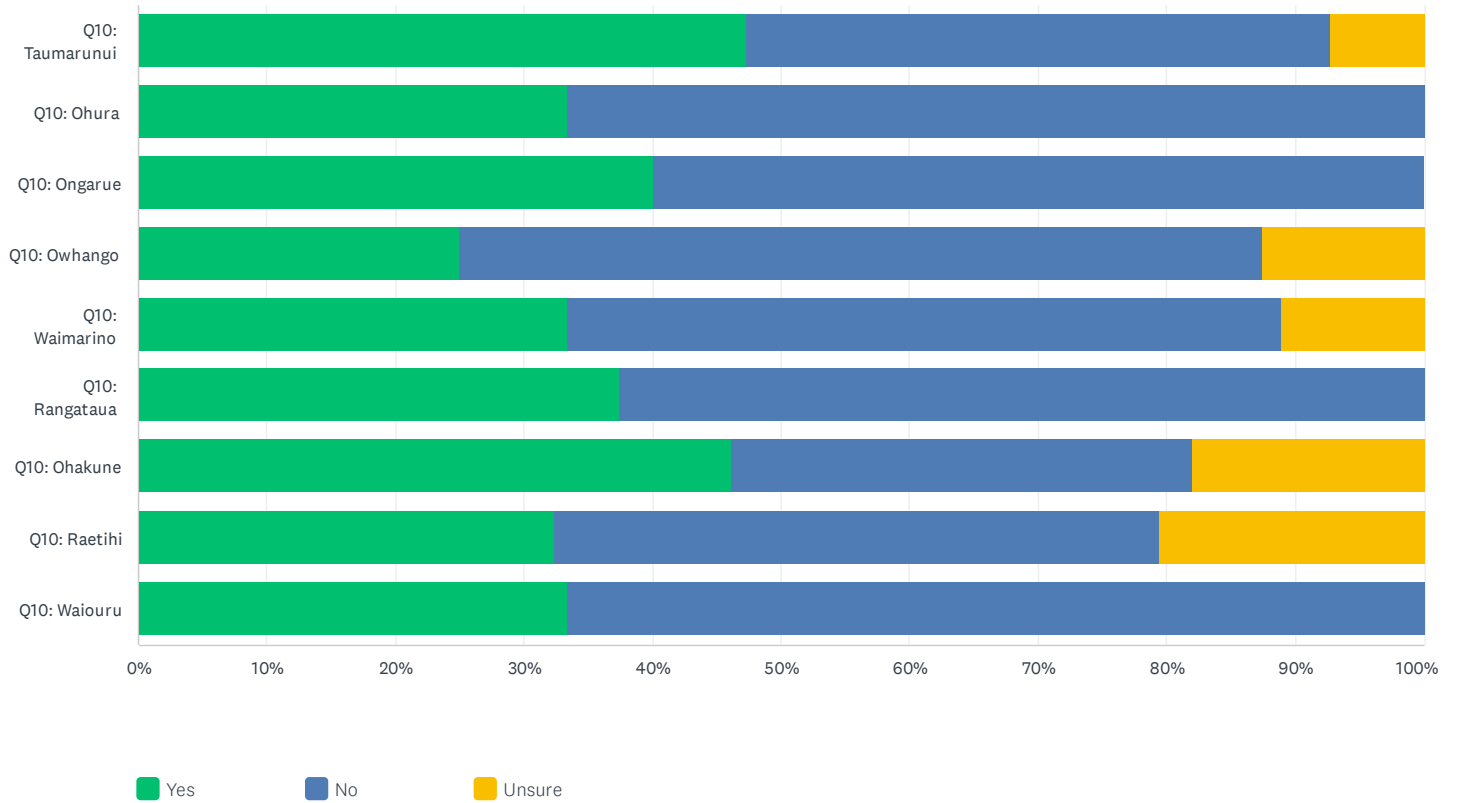

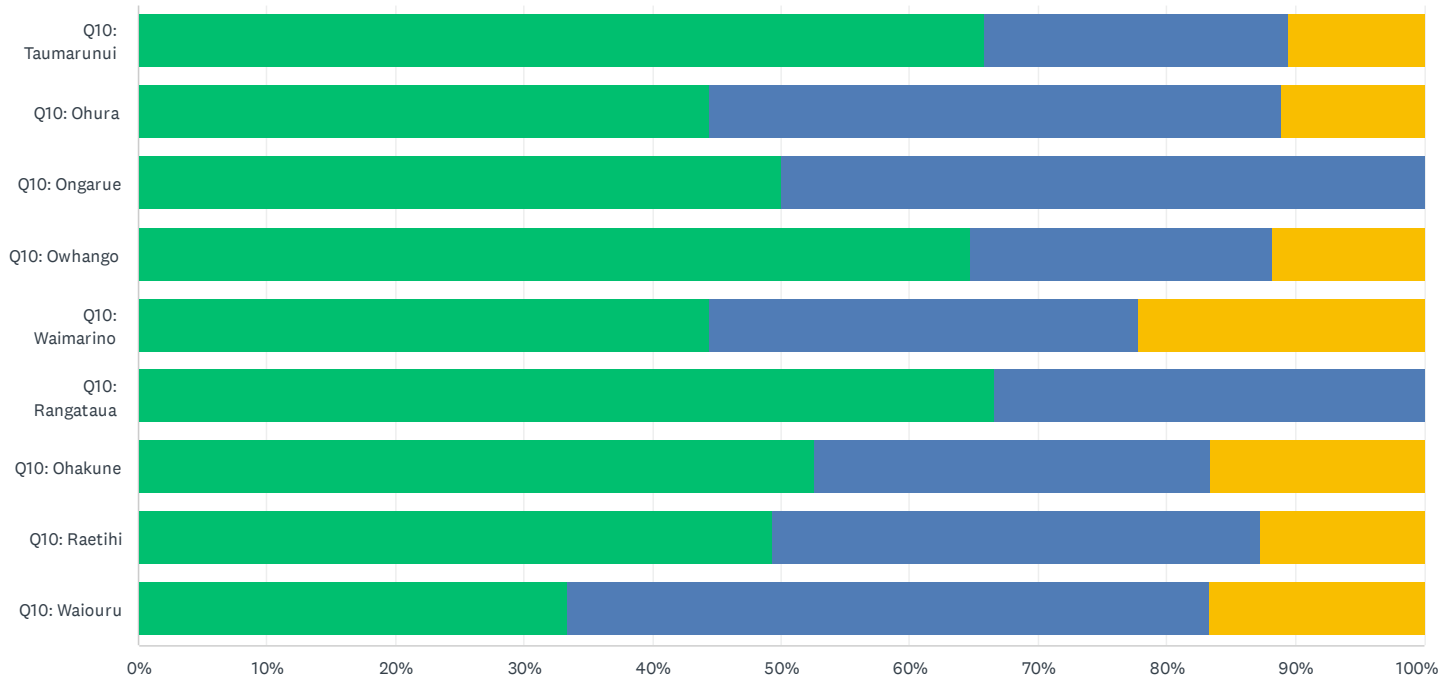

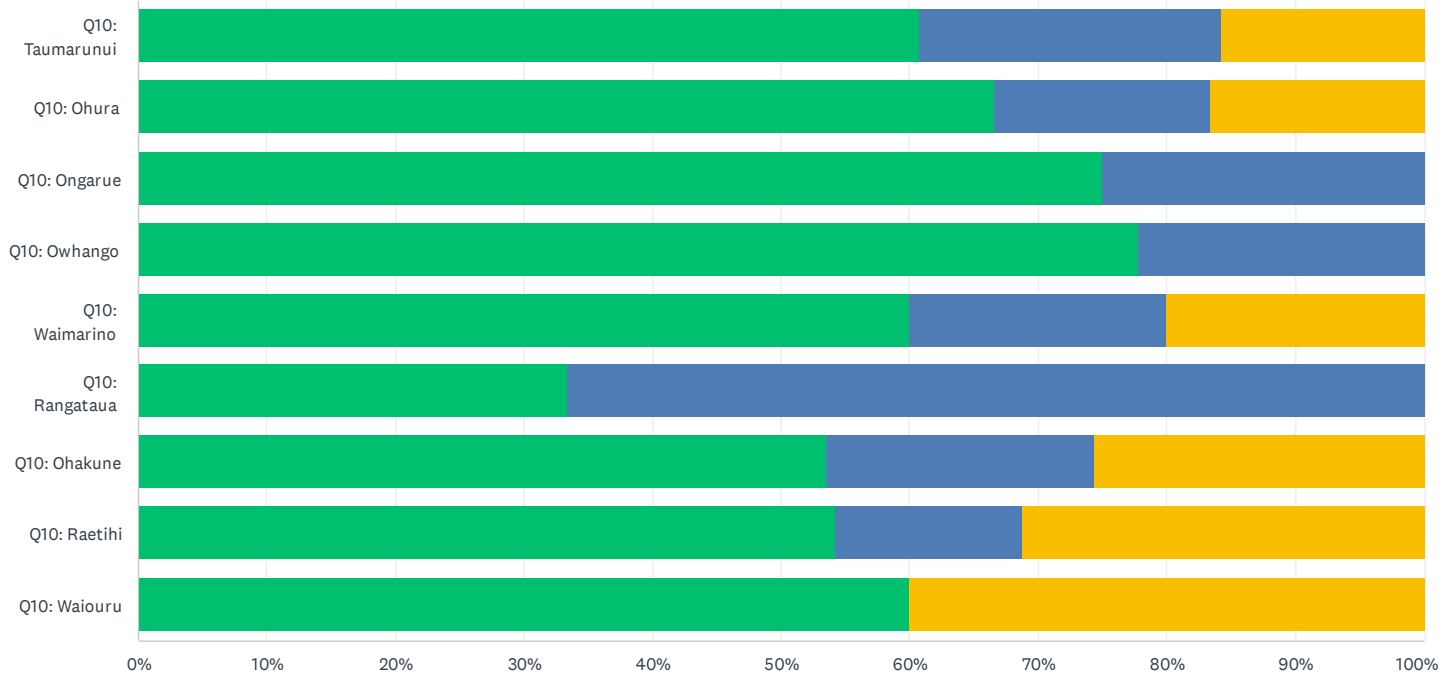

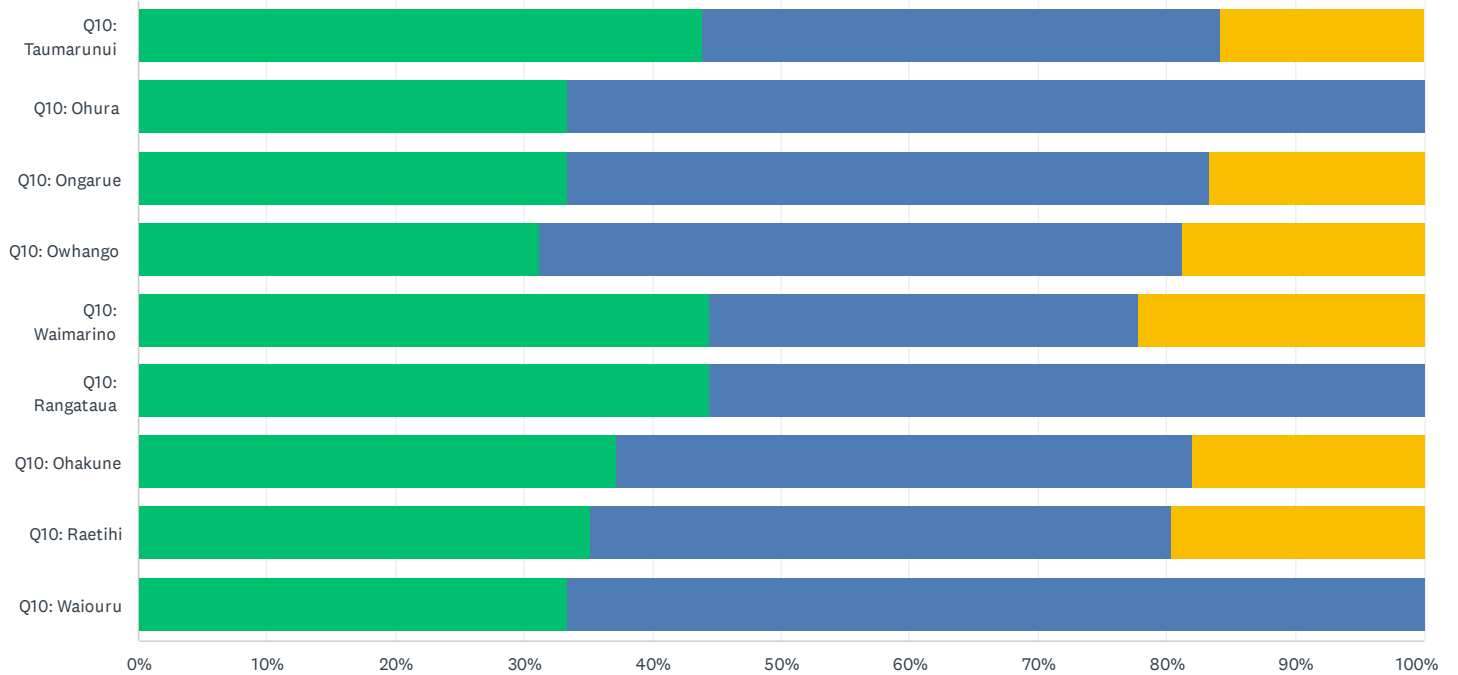

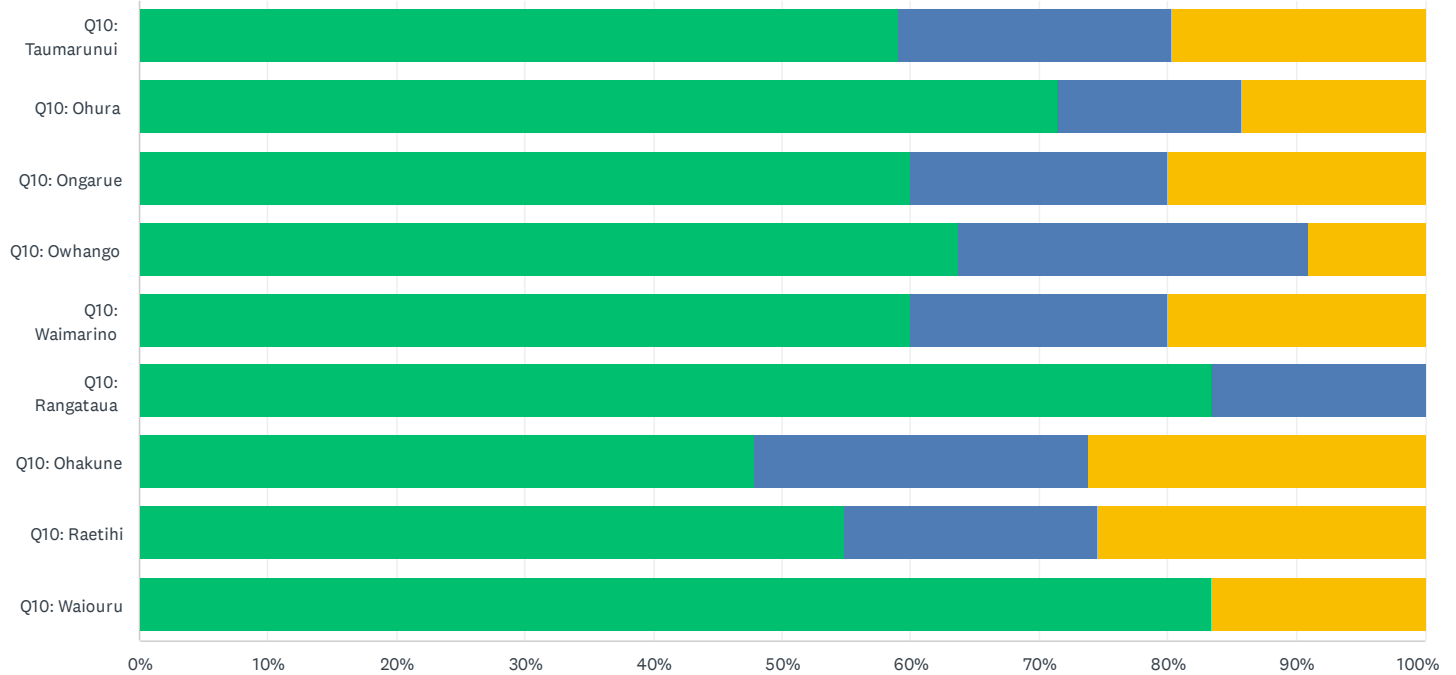

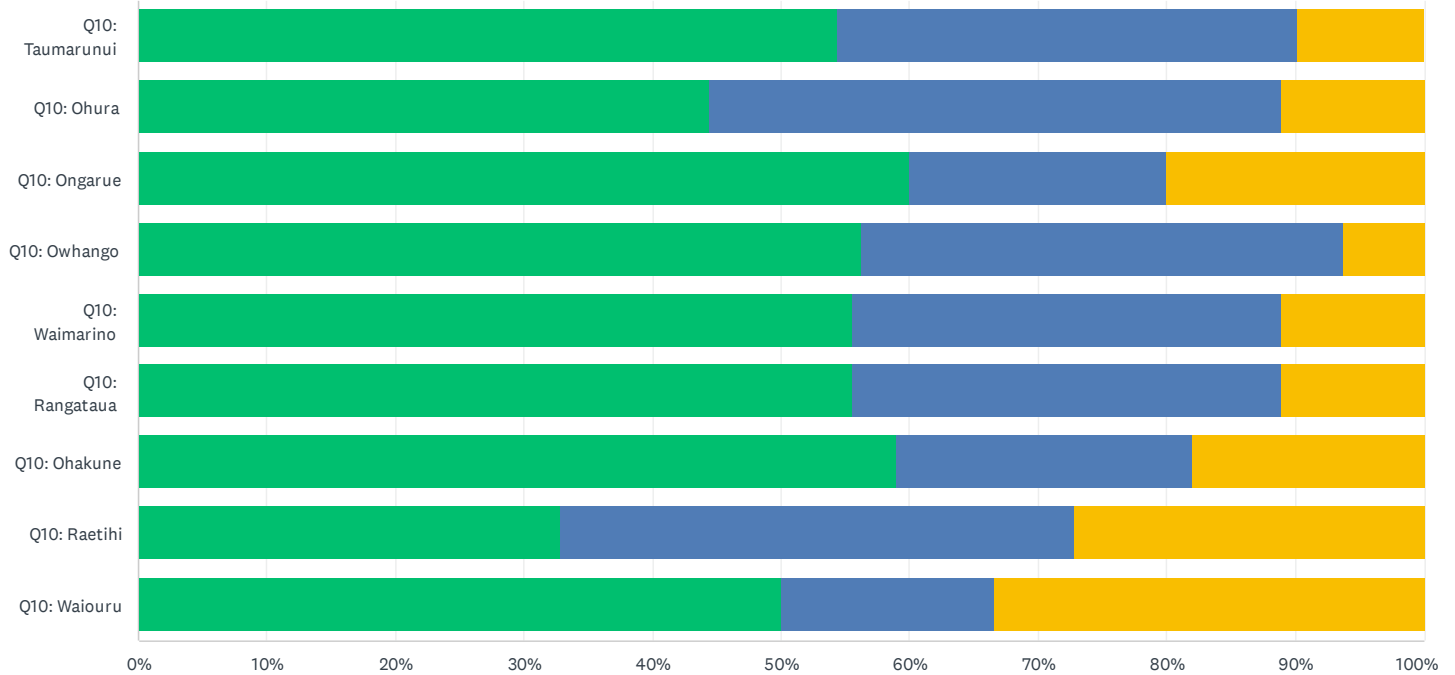

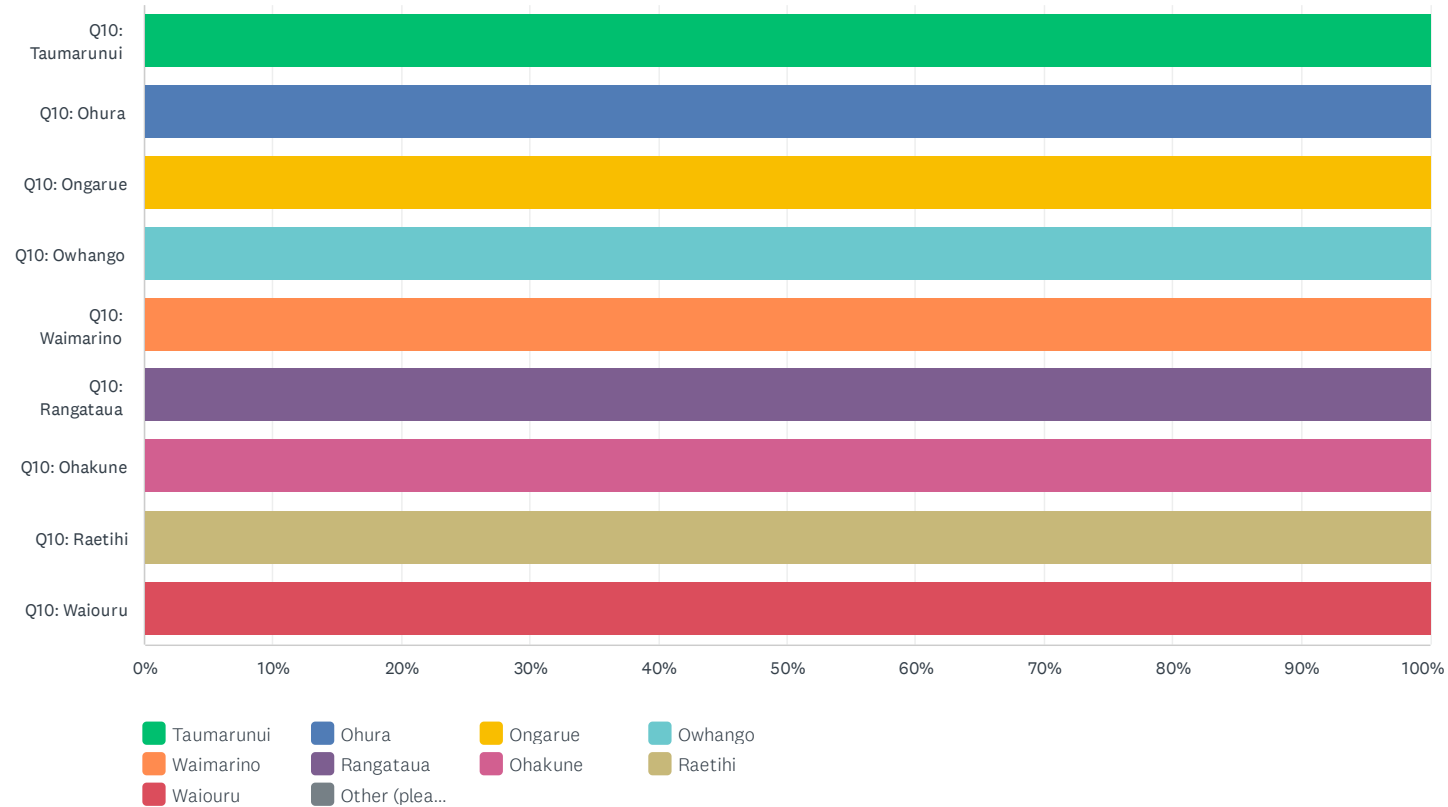
