- Yoghurt Containers
- Food Scraps
- Cups, Plates, Saucers
- Paint and Rope
- Ice Cream Containers
- Margarine Containers
- Meat Trays
- Laundry Bottles

- Mirrors
- Pyrex, Ceramics or Arcroc
- Broken Glass

Paper/Cardboard

- Painted or Waxed Paper
- Juice Cartons
- Pizza Boxes
- McDonalds Boxes

Glass

- Light Bulbs
- Drinking Glasses
- Window Glass

Other

- Nappies

Lost or stolen blue bins can be replaced for a small charge (Refer Fees and Charges Manual)

What Can I Recycle at Transfer Stations?

Glass — Plastic — Metal



Glass bottles/glass jars

Clean unbroken bottles and jars

Metal cans/tins

Steel and aluminium cans, *Washed and squashed*



Plastic containers/ bottles

Plastics displaying recycle symbols 1 and 2
Clean milk bottles, plastic drink bottles
Washed and squashed



Paper — Cardboard



Newspaper

Other Paper/ Glossies

Brown paper, magazines, books, leaflets, junk mail, telephone directories



Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard, cardboard boxes, egg cartons



WASHED and SQUASHED. FLATTENED and GROUPED



Kerbside Recycling

Kerbside recycling collection is not a complete refuse management system. It will cater for the vast majority of recyclables a household will create in a week.

However it will **NOT** cope with:

- Your cardboard boxes after you have changed flat or moved house
- Volumes of bottles and cans after a party
- Commercial volumes

Please take large quantities to the transfer stations.

Collection Days

Monday	Ohakune, Rangataua, Raetihi.
Thursday	Taumarunui, Manunui, Piriaka, Kakahi, Mahoe
Public Holidays	Regardless of day—it will be collected.

Please Note:

- Your refuse and recycling should be at the kerbside by 7.30am on collection day.
- All recycling items go into your blue bin—limited to **one** bin per household.
- Refuse for disposal must be in an official Council pink rubbish bag. We collect 2-3 bags. Any more should be taken to a transfer station.

Official rubbish bags can be purchased from Council Service Centres and local shops.
