To do this you need Internet access:

- Go to <u>www.ruapehudc.govt.nz</u> and find the link to "Libraries" under "Our Facilities".
- Click the "Library Catalogue" symbol, then access "Research databases" from the Library catalogue page.
- To enter one of the links, you will be prompted for your user id, which is your library borrower barcode number.

Access is also available from the Ruapehu District Libraries APN computers and WiFi (look under 'Get Info' – 'Subscription Databases' or ask staff for assistance).
