DECISION

This is an application by Saksham Rajput for a Manager's Certificate to assist with the management of Monsoon Indian Cuisine.

The criteria to be considered under section 222 is as follows;

- A) Suitability.
- B) Relevant convictions.
- C) Experience, in particular recent experience in controlling a licensed premises.
- D) Recent training and evidence they hold the Licence Controller Qualification.
- E) Matters in the Inspector and Police reports.

Other requirements are;

- F) The applicant must be over 20 years of age.
- G) The applicant is working on a licensed premises that requires a manager.
- H) The application is supported by an appropriate reference from the employer.

Reports have been obtained by the Inspector and the Police and there is no opposition but the following undertaking is noted because of visa restrictions; The manager's certificate will be used by the applicant only in the course of his employment with Monsoon Indian Cuisine Restaurant.

Summary and decision.

The committee must consider all the criteria and requirements before the manager's certificate can be issued and the committee is satisfied that all the criteria and requirements are met. The application is granted for 12-months subject to an undertaking that the manager's certificate will be used by the applicant only in the course of his employment with Monsoon Indian Cuisine Restaurant.
