# IMPORTANT TIPS ABOUT RECYCLING IN RUAPEHU!

- Please make sure all your recyclable are clean.
- Clear meat trays are recyclable, remove plastic wrap put into your pink bag.
- We CANNOT recycle Tetra packaging. e.g. Long Life Milk, Alternative Milks etc...
- We can recycle plastics (1) (2) (5)

  for plastics numbered 5, we can only accept food packing items
- Remove lids from all bottles and jars and put the lids into your pink bag.
- Squash all plastic containers.
- Recycling must be clean.
- Put recycling in blue bin, rubbish in pink bag
- Flatten all cardboard.
- Official blue recycling bins and green food waste bins can be purchased from all council offices.
- All broken glass should be wrapped in newspaper and put into your pink bag.









Your blue bin should be at the kerbside by 8:00AM on collection day. If you have more recycling taken then to your local transfer station.

On public holidays all kerbside collection will be as per your normal day expect for Christmas Day and New Years Day. They will be collected the following day.

There are two trucks, one for green bins and one for blue bins and pink bags. The trucks come at different times, which may be some hours apart.

Put your blue bin out on the same day\* as your pink bag and green bin. \*except for Waiouru see back of brochure

Did you know that you can take your used household batteries, cellphone and laptop batteries to any council offices to be disposed of responsibly on your behalf. All other batteries can be taken to our transfer stations.
