A VISION FOR OHAKUNE

Ruapehu District Council in partnership with Ngāti Rangī and Ohakune inc. have been working with the recently formed Future Ohakune Reference Group (made up of representatives from the community, Ngāti Rangī, big and local businesses, farming and market gardeners) to establish some initial ideas and propose some potential objectives, initiatives and projects for the future of Ohakune.

We would love to hear what you think of the ideas. Are there things we have missed; do you feel some things should be prioritised over others. The outcome of this process will influence councils Long Term Planning Process and ensure funding is set aside for the things the community feel is most important.
