Important Information

Permit Fee

The fees for Application for Permit to Operate an Amusement Device are set pursuant to Section 11(6) of the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978.

Site Inspection Fee

The Site Inspection Fee is set pursuant to Section 12 of the Local Government Act 2002.

Where a charge is inadequate to enable Council to recover its actual and reasonable costs in respect of the matter concerned, Council may require the applicant to pay a charge to cover the costs incurred by Council.

Amusement Device Regulations 1978

Section 11 of the Amusement Device Regulations 1978, "Local Authority permit" states:

- (2) A local authority to which an application for a permit is made shall, before issuing it, cause the site and device to be inspected by the local authority engineer or some other competent person.
- (3) Every person inspecting an amusement device pursuant to subclause (2) of this regulation shall have regard to whether:
 - (a) The ground on which the device is erected is capable of supporting it without risk of subsidence.
 - (b) There is sufficient clearance between any part of the device and any fixed or moving objects in its vicinity to prevent injury to any person when the device is in operation.
 - (c) Such protective fences or barriers as the local authority may require are erected.
 - (d) In all other respects, the erection and proposed operation of the device complies with the local authority's bylaws.
